General outline of the conference

For years, the International Scientific Conference Euro-Trans has been combining the academic and scientific environment with economic practice and creates a platform for exchanging the latest knowledge, scientific and research achievements and innovative solutions implemented in the area of transport. This year, speeches and discussion panels will be related to the topic of artificial intelligence, of which solutions are increasingly used in practice, which reflects the scope of development of digital technologies and the pace of implementation of the latest achievements. In various environments and media, the particular significance of artificial intelligence is indicated in the process of developing mobility systems and in managing supply chains.

Discussion devoted to these issues had a limited scope so far, which prompted the organizers of the Euro-Trans conference to invite academic community, employees of scientific institutes and representatives of the public and private sector to prepare and present their views during the conference, including the results of already conducted research and carried out implementation projects.

Discussions will be conducted as part of the following thematic sessions:

- Artificial intelligence what is it and how to use it? thematic session,
- Transport and mobility market and social challenges thematic and poster sessions.
